To help you through this change should you desire to continue carrying SRN News, we are leaving all Moody-1 Network breaks and network relays in place. You'll be able to program your automation system to transition from Moody-1 to your SRN receiver and back.

The News Addendum to the Moody Radio Affiliation Agreement will terminate effective June 30, 2022. The final invoice and billing for News from Moody Radio will be issued in early June, which will cover all SRN News programming through July 1, 2022.

The proliferation of digital devices is making it possible for listeners to secure their news and information when they want it, however, for those of you who would like to continue having a news presence, we are working with another organization to provide you with up to five 3-minute newscasts throughout the day, five days a week beginning in fall 2022. We will share more on this opportunity in future communications.

In the interim, we are here to help you with your programming decisions by providing the attached **Proposed Moody-1 Program Schedule July 1, 2022** denoting the placement of all breaks and scheduled short features. Note, a newer 3-minute feature from Baptist Press called **Good News for Today**, spotlighting positive news stories of Christians and churches around the world who are making a kingdom impact, is being made available on Amb-OS and may be worth adding to your lineup.
